Value of Fluency for students reading below Pack Level F: Following are comments from Sandy Ridge, WILDCAT READERS Coordinator, North Union Elementary School. Sandy used fluency passages for students at Levels C, D & E: "This was a great confidence builder for these student who are considered non-readers. Also, it was constant exposure to those words over and over again by reading the fluency passage daily along with the book. The students loved graphing their results and seeing their progress! I think it actually was more beneficial than it is at some of our higher levels where the focus switches more to comprehension and reading for deeper meaning. I am very glad we added this to our program." North Union Elementary currently has 86 students receiving 1:1 reading mentoring.
